The Kalpitiya experience

Ranamure village excursion

Visit paddy fields and enjoy a rice worker's breakfast, explore the forest and drop by a local school or temple en route to an elder's home for a cooking lesson and Sri Lankan curry lunch

Camping with sea turtles in Rekawa

Camp in close proximity to the golden sands of Rekawa beach and see large numbers of sea turtles come ashore and crawl onto the beach to lay eggs

Sinharaja night trek

Spot lesser flying squirrels, slender Lorises and much more during a beguiling night trek through the primeval Sinharaja forest, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve and World Heritage Site

Whale watching by air

Enjoy bird's-eye views of the world's largest mammals with a dramatic guided tour in a seaplane flying over whales off the coast of Sri Lanka
